Complete full papers must be received no later than February 20, 2013.

CONFERENCE LANGUAGE

The official language for the Conference is English. All papers and presentations should be prepared in English.

PUBLICATION

The thumb drive containing all conference manuscripts together with an abstract booklet will be distributed to delegates at the conference registration desk. All the presenters (plenary, invited, contributed oral, and poster) are kindly encouraged to submit their manuscripts.

Manuscripts will be peer-reviewed and recommended to publish on international journals (Indexed by SCI or EI) on request.

REGISTRATION

All prospective participants are advised to register early on-line. The rate of the registration fee depends on the type of participants and the date of registration. The accommodation information and the payment details will be announced in the second circular and on ICCR2013 website.
