GENERAL

Hangzhou's West Lake Cultural Landscape was inscribed on UNESCO's World Heritage List in 2011.

SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS AND PAPERS

All Papers and Abstracts should be prepared strictly in the format of the Templates with MS Word (see the conference website: <http://www.doe.zju.edu.cn/ICCR2013>). The Abstract should be prepared at least 300 words, which will be printed in the Abstract booklet for each participant. You can update your submitted Abstracts and Papers before March 20, 2013.

PUBLICATION

The thumb drive containing all conference manuscripts together with an abstract booklet (hard copy) will be distributed to delegates at the conference registration desk. All the presenters (plenary, invited, contributed oral, and poster) are kindly encouraged to submit their manuscripts.

Manuscripts will be peer-reviewed and recommended to publish on International Journal of Refrigeration, International and Journal of Air Conditioning and Refrigeration (Indexed by SCI and EI) on request.

GETTING TO ICCR 2013

The conference site will be at the Zijingang campus of Zhejiang University. (Google Map or GPS setting: 30.30594 N, 120.08556 E).

It is convenient to get to the conference site from the Hangzhou International Airport and railway station. Upon arriving in Hangzhou, taxis services are available at Hangzhou Xiaoshan Airport terminal 24 hours a day. A typical fare for Hangzhou Xiaoshan Airport to Zijingang Campus of Zhejiang University is about RMB180 Yuan. You could also take the airport shuttle charged RMB20 Yuan to the downtown of Hangzhou city, then transfer to Hotel or Zhejiang University (Zijingang campus) by a taxi charged about RMB30 Yuan.

If there is no direct flight from your city to Hangzhou, you may choose Beijing, Shanghai or Hong Kong as a transfer station. There are scheduled flights from Beijing or Hong Kong to Hangzhou Xiaoshan Airport everyday, which may takes no more than 2 hours. You can also take high-speed trains from Shanghai to Hangzhou. The time to travel from Shanghai to Hangzhou is less than one hour, and the cost is about RMB 124 (US \$20) for a first class ticket or RMB 78 (US \$ 12) for a second class ticket. You could take subway, taxi or bus to the Shanghai Railway Station from the Shanghai Pudong International Airport. There are also shuttle buses from Pudong International Airport to Hangzhou; however, this option is not recommended because of unreliable service.

POST-CONFERENCE TOUR

A three day's Traveling Itinerary to Yellow Mountain and two day's Traveling Itinerary to Putuo Mountain have been suggested. Other Traveling Itineraries can also be selected with the help of the travel agency guide at On-site Registration. The post-conference tour will start on April 10 morning in Hangzhou and end in Hangzhou. The traveling expenses for each person are depended on the selected traveling itinerary.
